Hi Folks

Welcome to the Summer Newsletter , A big thank you to Lorna for compiling it for us .

I hope you are all enjoying your sailing at Setley during this lovely summer weather , it really is a fantastic place this time of year .Unfortunately there have been complaints from local residents of noise. Fortunately it would appear to be caused by a group of NON members who are turning up in the evenings to sail IC and fast boats. It has been highlighted to the FC and is being investigated by them so you may see more wardens around than usual and I would ask members to let me have any information you can gather to help us catch them especially the time/day of the week they are sailing ? Please do not approach them, if you do they will say they have permission which is NOT TRUE (confirmed to me by the FC), we are the only permit holders to sail at the pond. Please can I ask members to refrain from sailing non scale fast electric boats at the moment .(NB fast scale launches are Ok within the fast boat area please)

Please note that I have re-published the nominated sailing areas to be used on club days on the website and I would ask you to please ensure that you comply, this will help prevent expensive accidents.

I must apologise for having to cancel the Richard Graham trophy but it has now been rescheduled for 12th August, so I look forward to seeing you there .

For all you “Grey Funnel Buffs” we are holding Navy day on 8th July 9am until 1pm so come along bring your models to display at the lakeside and show them off performing on the water .

I am now starting to compile the exhibitors list for the Annual Charity Show at Milford On Sea on 1st September so please send me an e mail or phone to let me know if you wish to participate. Please note that set up will be on the Friday evening .

A short while ago I was approached by Jim Forrester to ask if we would consider holding a “Gaff Rig/Vintage Yacht Day “run on the same lines as Navy Day , (lakeside display and on water sailing), I sent out an E mail to all members to see if there was sufficient interest but I only received three replies including Jim so at this time I will not be proceeding with planning the event .

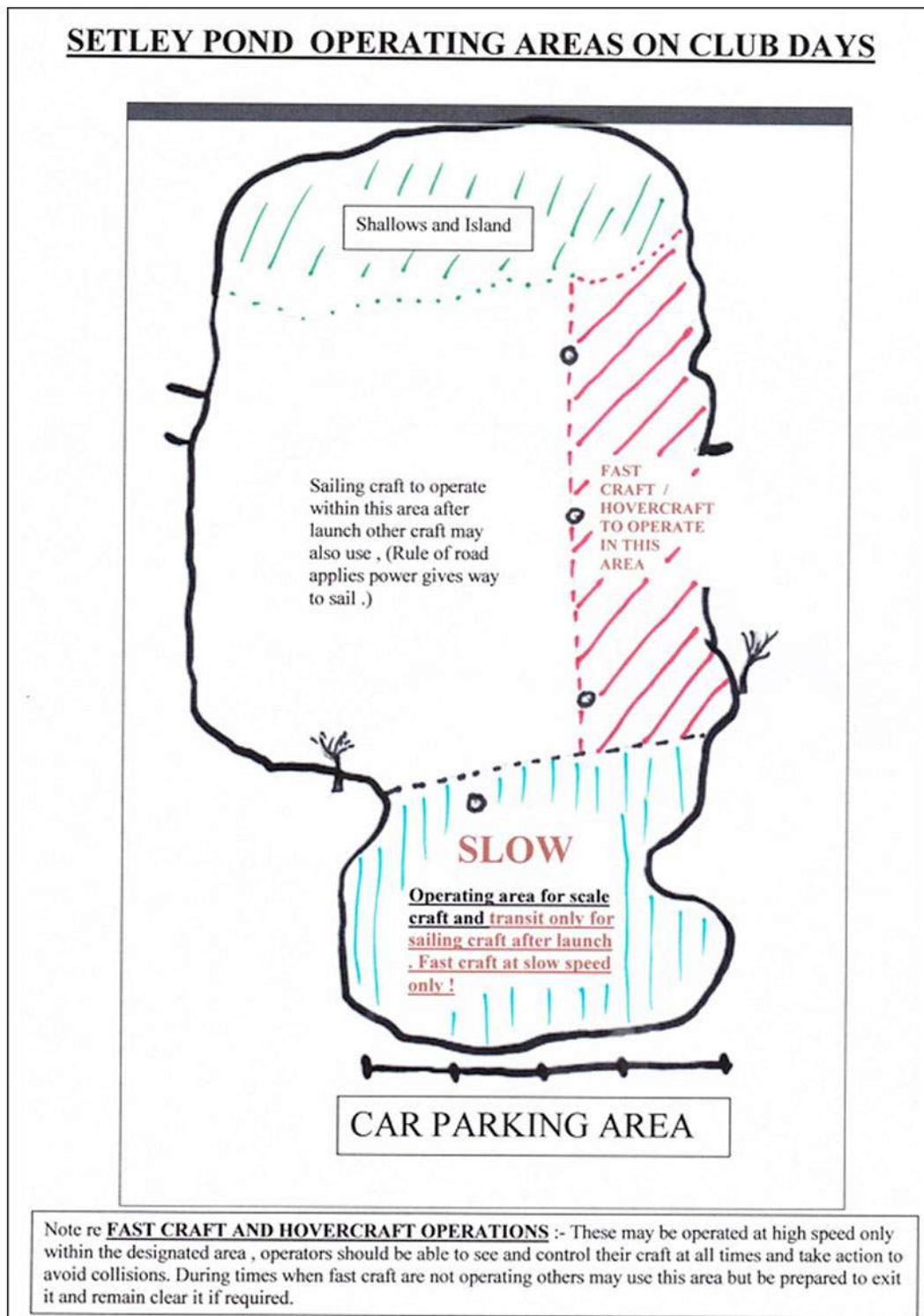

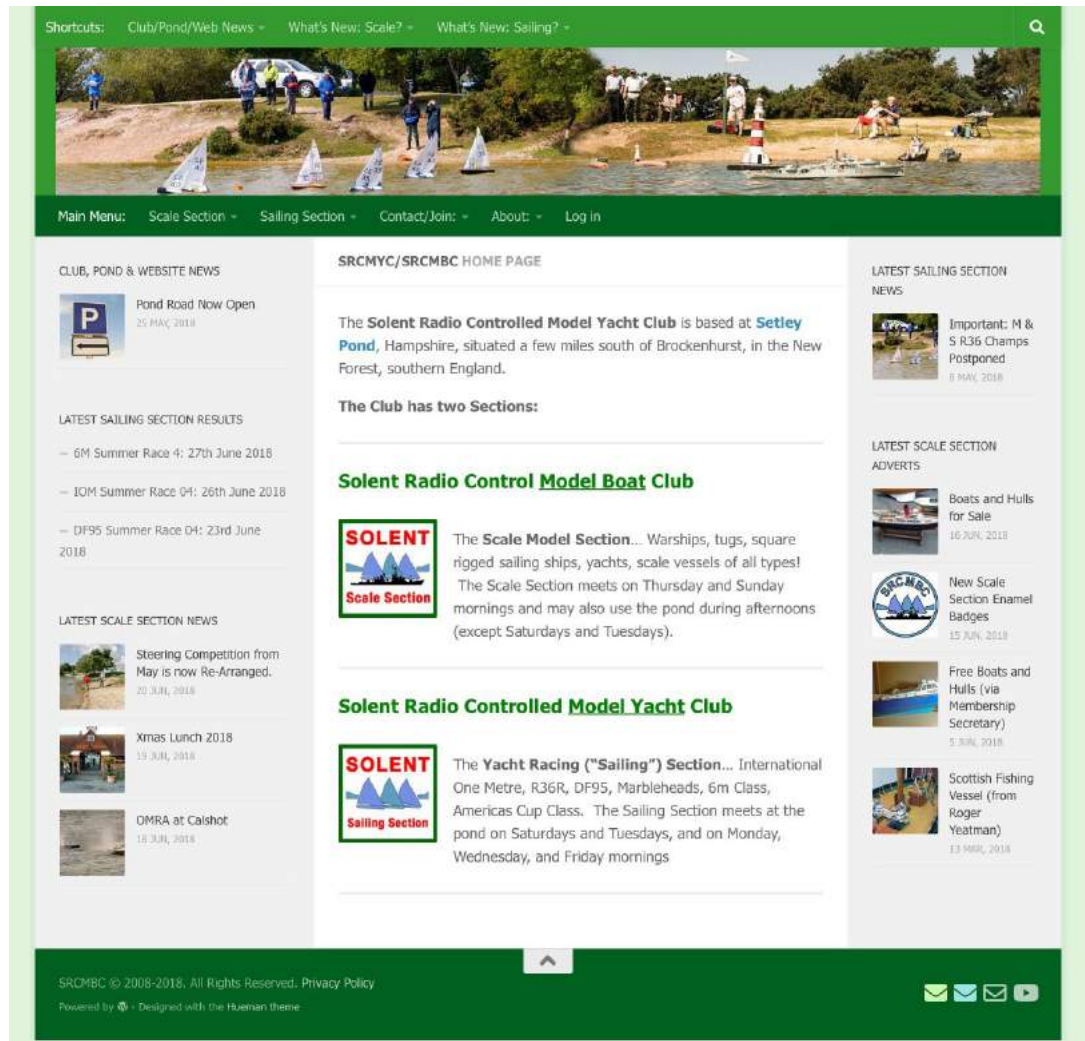
Boats for sale or free
