

KEYRINGS


Peter a member in South Africa has recently made the club scale and sailing keyrings, the club are selling them for £2.00 each, if anyone would like one, please contact Lorna.

Or if any member would like to sell their boats, please contact Peter Taylor or Lorna to arrange items to be put on website.





SETLEY POND OPERATING AREAS ON CLUB DAYS

FORESTRY ENGLAND

The permit for this year has now been signed by Nigel Burt the Sailing Section Captain, as they are the Permit Holders for both Sections.

He has had a few problems that needed ironing out before the permit could be signed. Our Thanks go out to him for doing all this work with the Forestry, it has not been easy.

For example

They needed a Customer Account request form so they could raise an Invoice (never asked for before)

Application form to request a Permit, including map showing our paths to the pond (never been asked for before)

Public Liability Insurance, they needed £10 million but no insurance company will do that amount only £5 million as our sport is low risk, they have agreed £5 million.

A Revised Risk Assessment – our Assessment did not have anything regarding sailing in adverse weather (hopefully no one would feel the need too)

Covid measures – these have not changed, copy on website.

Safeguarding Policy – for juniors if we ever have any.

Also, they are charging £315.00 this year, the scale section pays half, price will be more next year.

Please also remember the rules of the pond, we are only permitted a maximum of twelve boats being sailed on the water at any one time, unfortunately on busy club days this may mean that members may from time to time have to take a voluntary break to allow others to sail to enable compliance.

Sailing times are 9am to 7 pm.
